

## Rules of the Road

- Always wear a bike helmet and any other recommended safety gear.
- Obey all applicable traffic regulations, signs, signals and markings.
- 3. Keep right: drive with traffic, not against it.
- Watch out for drain grates, soft shoulders and other road surface hazards.
- Watch out for car doors opening or for cars pulling out into traffic.
- Don't carry passengers or packages that interfere with your vision or control.
- 7. Never hitch a ride on a truck or other vehicle.
- Be extremely careful at intersections, especially when making a left turn.
- Use hand signals to indicate turning or stopping.
- Protect yourself at night with red reflectors and lights. Wear white or light-colored clothing.
- 11. Drive a safe bike. Have it inspected to insure good mechanical condition.
- 12. Drive your bike defensively. Watch out for the other guy.

## Village of Itasca


Population: 8302
