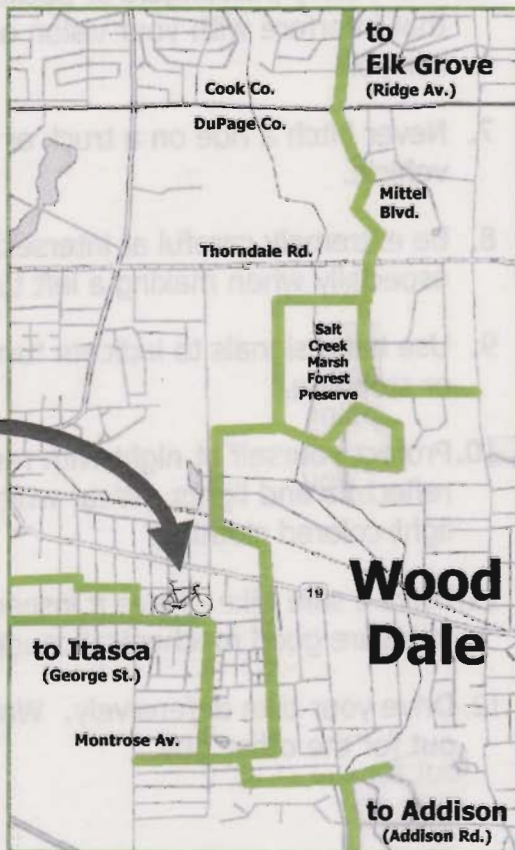

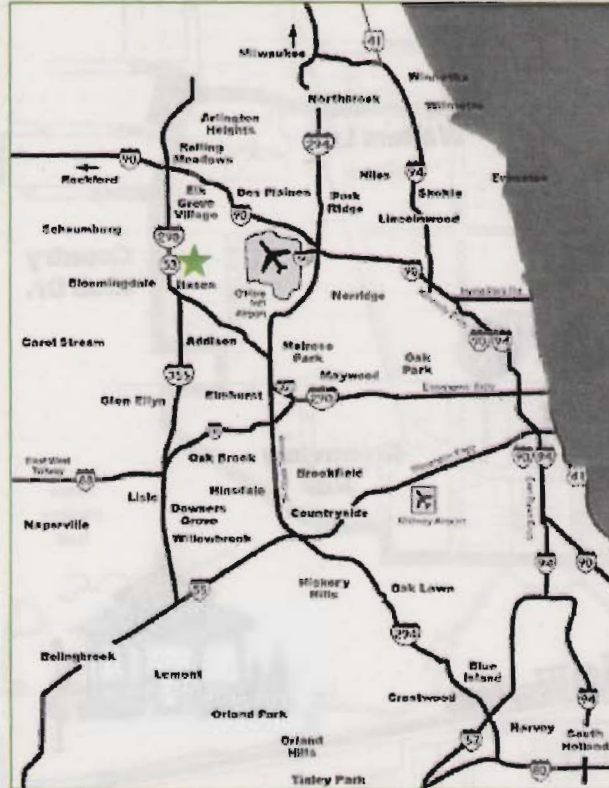

## Rules of the Road

1. Always wear a bike helmet and any other recommended safety gear.
2. Obey all applicable traffic regulations, signs, signals and markings.
3. Keep right: drive with traffic, not against it.
4. Watch out for drain grates, soft shoulders and other road surface hazards.
5. Watch out for car doors opening or for cars pulling out into traffic.
6. Don't carry passengers or packages that interfere with your vision or control.
7. Never hitch a ride on a truck or other vehicle.
8. Be extremely careful at intersections, especially when making a left turn.
9. Use hand signals to indicate turning or stopping.
10. Protect yourself at night with red reflectors and lights. Wear white or light-colored clothing.
11. Drive a safe bike. Have it inspected to insure good mechanical condition.
12. Drive your bike defensively. Watch out for the other guy.
